- Why should you be accepted into the weather camp?  
(*please add anything else that we should know about you*)

Two letters of Recommendation (one **must** be from your science teacher). These should not only detail past information but also why you would be a prime candidate for weather camp.  
(*These should be provided by non-family members and **MUST** be enclosed with the application*)
